What to Wear: PE attire and runners/basketball shoes with socks. Please ensure students bring a warm school jumper/hoodie.

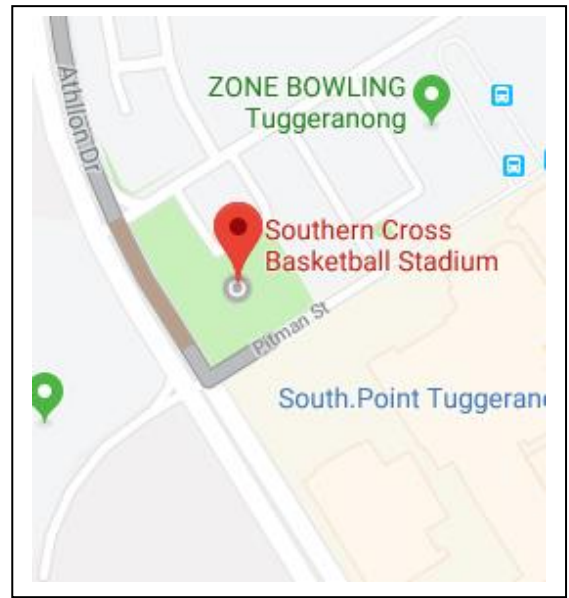
