Due to space constraints school bags are left at school. Students should bring lunch and recess packed separately in labelled paper bags. Although we do not usually promote this, a disposable water bottle would be helpful on this occasion because of space constraints. To make it easier for students to eat lunch and recess it is best to pack finger food such as sandwiches and fruit. Items such as yoghurts or meals in thermoses or reusable containers are not recommended when attending excursions.
