Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Week 8 - it is hard to believe that there are only two weeks left of term. We hope that you are making the most of the spring weather with your families. As we are all getting outdoors more, it is good to remind your children about being safe when cycling and walking around known magpie areas. A reminder that from 1 August, students are required to wear a sun safe hat, please help your child to remember to pack theirs. Please also ensure that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled so that lost items can be more easily returned.

Learning Journeys

Year three and preschool invited families to their learning journeys this week. In year three we saw students presenting evidence of their scientific experiments, explaining the scientific process of making predictions and drawing conclusions. Some students showed us how a lava lamp works, shared videos of chemical reactions and used practical equipment to explain how warm and cold water behave differently. Staff and parents were impressed with the depth of scientific knowledge and skill they had.

In preschool, students shared their latest inquiry 'Play helps us investigate our world'. It was an open classroom where parents could participate in activities that showed how children learn through play. Students and parents participated in science experiments, fine motor activities, and literacy and numeracy activities. Students proudly showed their parents around the classroom and shared the learning and growth they have made since the beginning of the year. We had great feedback from the learning journeys this week and we are grateful that so many parents were able to attend.

'Step into the Limelight'

In arts news, we are extremely proud of our singers, drummers and dancers this week for participating in the 'Step into the Limelight' 2023 Gala Showcase. Quick and easy, it can be accessed 24/7 on PC, Mac or mobile app.

School Uniform orders for existing students will be delivered to your child's classroom. Otherwise, orders can be collected from the front office.

Ordering in person

Opening hours Wednesday 8.30 to 10:00am and Friday 2.30 to 4.00pm. We prefer payment by credit card, but we can accept cash.

With COVID continuing to present a risk we prefer that orders are made online where possible.

Secondhand requests can be emailed through to the shop manager.

Donations can be placed in the purple bin in the front office foyer.
