Semester 1 Reports – Important Information

Reports are automatically sent to the first two contacts listed on your child's SENTRAL profile. If either email address is incorrect or no longer in use, you may not receive the report. Please also note that, depending on your email settings, reports may be delivered to your junk or spam folder. If you have not received your child's report by COB 1st July, we encourage you to check these folders before contacting the school. If the report cannot be located, please email your child's classroom teacher, who will notify the administration team so that another copy can be sent.

Thank you for your assistance in ensuring your contact details are up to date.

We would also like to remind parents and carers that, due to the current protected industrial action, Semester 1 school reports will not include individual written comments. If you have any concerns about your child's learning please reach out to their class teacher.

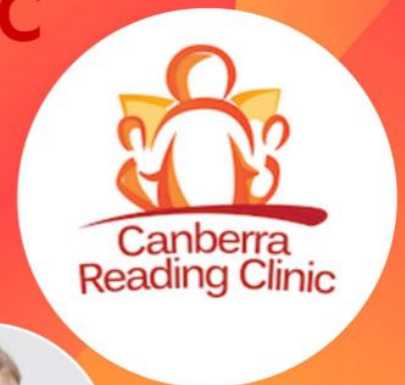
