Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our commitment to Positive Education we have dedicated most of this newsletter to health and wellbeing, and included some resources that you may find useful.

Our school wide Positive Education focus this term is on the demonstration of 'respect': respect for our environment, each other and ourselves. This is connected to the IB Learner Profile attributes of being caring, principled, open-minded and communicators. At assemblies, in class, in the corridors and on the playground, we are constantly reminding students what respect looks and sounds like. We are positively reinforcing the students' demonstration of respectful behaviour and attitudes through a new token system.

Each term will have a different focus. When students demonstrate the focus behaviour/attitude staff members can positively acknowledge this by handing them a 'gold' token. At the front office we have four colourful containers, one for each school house. The students take their gold tokens to the front office and place them in the correct container for their house, thereby contributing to house points. At the end of each term our student leaders will count the tokens and announce the winning house at assembly. The famous Red Hill 'Golden Gnome' has been reinstated and will be proudly wrapped in the scarf of the winning house until the end of the following term.


2024 ENROLMENTS ARE OPEN
