

Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you are making the most of the beautiful spring weather with your children and taking care not to go too close to our nesting magpies. As we are all getting outdoors more, it is good to remind your children of being safe when cycling and walking around known magpie areas. With the return of warmer days, students are required to wear a sun safe hat and bring a fresh bottle of water to drink. Please ensure that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled so that lost items can be more easily returned. It is hard to believe that there is only two weeks left of term.

Over the past fortnight our youngest students have participated in a variety of learning experiences including Preschool Science Fun days, experiments, basketball clinics and school incursions and excursions to local facilities such as Questacon. At the moment, many of the junior school teams are transitioning to new units of inquiry and reflecting and culminating on their past ones. Our junior students celebrated Book Week in style, sporting some of the best homemade costumes we have seen. Thank you to all the parents, grandparents and special friends that participated in our walk and stayed on for a lovely chat at the morning tea. It was wonderful to see so many of our community supporting Book Week and the Walkathon.

Later this term the students will participate in the annual Jump Rope for Heart fundraising event. Skipping ropes are available for sale each morning on the asphalt, and it is great to see children already improving their skipping stamina in anticipation of this event.

Red Hill celebrated NAIDOC week with the following events; daily story telling by our Indigenous Education Officers Darcy and Zuzette, classroom learning experiences and the hosting of the Great Book Swap by our Deadly Boomerangs student action group. The funds raised from this event will go toward buying books for remote Indigenous communities.

In recent weeks students have been arriving at school before 8:50am, teachers start before school supervision at 8:50am. Could we please ask that families drop their children to school at or after 8:50am to ensure safety for all. It has also been brought to our attention that some of our kindergarten students are being put at risk at pick up time by drivers double parking, blocking other drivers and limiting visibility for children being put into cars. As a general reminder if your children are in kindergarten they are picked up from the carpark, if they are in years 1 and 2 then they should be collected from the Kiss and Go area on Astrolabe Street. Years 3 to 6 are not dismissed until 3:15pm so there should not be any senior pickups in the car park until after this time please. Lastly, we would also like to remind the school community to NOT park in the bus stop lane. Please use the designated Kiss and Go area for pickups.
